REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MAY 14, 2019

The COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALLATIN met MAY 14, 2019 for their regular monthly meeting. The meeting was called to order at 6:43 pm by Mayor Juanita Cotton.

Members present were: Mayor Cotton, Mary Nell Zehren, Kathy Dethlefs, Ashley Dethlefs, Murphy Milligan, and Donna Morris. **Correction: Carol Folkes also present.**

The VFD did not have anything to report.

The minutes from the previous month's meeting were read and the financial report given by Donna Morris. There was a motion by Kathy Dethlefs and seconded by Ashley Dethlefs to accept the minutes and financial report as read. All voted aye and motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Tom Trimble explained the ordinance to deny ONCORE rate increase. In order for the city to deny the rate increase we must approve an ordinance to do so. There was a motion by Ashley Dethlefs and seconded by Mary Nell Zehren to approve the ordinance to deny a rate increase. All voted aye and the motion carried.

The 501c tax class request and separate EIN for Community Center were tabled until after the Gopher Fest. Flooring for the Community Center was also tabled.

We went over an updated Vendor/Donation list for the Gopher Fest.

Murphy Milligan and Mayor Cotton will work together on the HMAP revisions for 2019.

New Business:

One ceiling fan at the Community Center fell to the floor and the other one is just hanging from the ceiling. Mayor Cotton talked to Kenneth McKnight about reinstalling the fans so they will not fall. He was also asked to replace electrical outlets in the kitchen area so there won't be an overload on the breaker.

There was a discussion about closing in a corner in the big room at the Community Center for a storage room with shelves. Donna Morris said she will ask James Morris if he would be interested in taking on the project. Mayor Cotton will ask Kenneth McKnight to give us an estimate.

There was a motion by Kathy Dethlefs and seconded by Mary Nell Zehren to accept Carol Folkes application for a seat on the city council, to fill the unexpired term of Jane Bolden. All voted aye and motion carried.

Having no further business there was a motion by Ashley Dethlefs and seconded by Kathy Dethlefs to adjourn. All voted aye and motion carried. **Correction:**
