REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
AUGUST 20, 2019

The COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALLATIN met August 20, 2019 for their regular monthly meeting. The meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm by Mayor Juanita Cotton. Tom Tremble offered the benediction.

Tom Calkin was present at the meeting and invited the council to have it's October meeting at his bed and breakfast (Tom and Bertie's). Tom is also a sponsor to the city web site by allowing a picture of his business to be one of the attractions in the area.

New Business:

Tom Tremble with ONCOR read and explained an ordinance to renew the franchise with the City of Gallatin. There was a motion by Ashley Dethlefs and seconded by Carol Folkes to accept the ordinance as presented. All voted aye and the motion carried.
