Regular Monthly Meeting  
October 15, 2019

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALLATIN met in a regular monthly meeting at the Gallatin Community Center with Mayor Juanita Cotton calling the meeting to order at 6:35 pm.

Members present were Mayor Cotton, Ashley Dethlefs, Kathy Dethlefs, and Mary Nell Zehren.

The Gallatin VFD did not have anything to report.

The minutes were read and the financial reports given by Donna Morris. There was a motion by Kathy Dethlefs and seconded by Mary Nell Zehren to accept the minutes and financial report as read. All voted aye and motion carried.

Old Business:

Community Center Issues

Wiring for new a/c for Community Center. We are waiting for an estimate from Kenneth McKnight.

New refrigerator and coffee maker for Community Center have been purchased and delivered.

New Curtains for the Community Center are pending purchase of light blocking lining for the fabric we have. The cost of the lining will be around \$3.99 a yard.

Updating of the Rental Contract for the Community Center was discussed. Mayor Cotton gave each council member a copy of the updated form to look over and discuss any additions or changes at our next meeting.

New Business:

Final approval and signing of Oncor Franchise Agreement. Ashley Dethlefs made a motion and Kathy Dethlefs seconded the motion to approve the Franchise Agreement. All voted aye and motion carried. The agreement was signed.

The Fall Fest plans were completed by assigning workers for each activity and deciding on the food to serve and where to set up each activity.

New Community Center issues:

The Church of Christ men's group will not be renting the Community Center for future -- Bible studies. That will mean a decrease in monthly income for the Community Center.

Some of the outside lighting is not working. Mayor Cotton will check with Oncor about the lights they service.

The commode in one of the bathrooms is not cutting off when flushed. Mayor Cotton said Larry Cotton will repair it if we supply the parts.

There was a suggestion that we purchase an all-weather mat to place at the entry door.

The curtains will need hardware to hang them when finished.

There was a motion by Ashley Dethlefs and seconded by Kathy Dethlefs to check on getting what is needed to fix commode, check on all-weather mat, check on fixing lights, and hardware for the curtains. All voted aye and motion carried.

Having no further business there was a motion by Ashley Dethlefs and seconded by Kathy Dethlefs to adjourn. All voted aye and motion carried. We were dismissed at 8:20pm.
